from 7th grade

“But what can one learn indeed in ancient Greek?”, will say the beotian...

We learn a language not to speak or to "communicate". We learn a language to explore literature and culture. We find the texts of those who, in Occident, invented democracy, theater, who cultivated philosophy, mathematics, physics and architecture ... Nothing less! Thales, Pythagoras, Plato, Aristotle, Sophocles and Homer, those are all Greeks!

During the school year, participants in this workshop will also confront the camera, in order to be discovered under different perspectives. A short performance will also be prepared to be presented at year-end promotions.

Supervised study (for secondary pupils)

from 5th to 7th grade

Study No. 1A

This supervised study is intended for students from 5th to 7th grade, in groups of 6 (min.) to 10 students (max.), under the supervision of a teacher or tutor.

It takes place between 15 h 45 and 16 h 45, with a different schedule on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 16 h 30 to 17 h 30 for pupils of 7th grade (fees on page 7 of « General Terms and Conditions 2010-2011 »).

Study No. 1S

This supervised study takes place from 15 h 45 to 16 h 25, available to students finishing school at 15 h 25. It is included in the tuition.

Study No. 2S

This supervised study takes place from 16 h 30 to 17 h 10, for pupils as of 4th grade. It is also included in the tuition.

Please note

It is important to respect the schedule. The attendance of these studies is mandatory for those who are registered. Any exemption must be requested in advance and in writing to the Prefecture.

Registration is done at the beginning of the new school year, by means of the form provided by the class teacher.
